In February 2017 second year acting students and technical students from Bristol Old Vic Theatre School toured 19 junior and secondary schools with a 1 hour adaptation of *Jason and The Argonauts*. A total of 3,216 children saw a performance at their school. In addition 498 children and adults came to two Saturday morning shows open to the general public at the Redgrave Theatre Bristol. Several were the families of the children who had seen the performance at school and who wanted to see it again.

As most days the students were performing to a different primary school each morning and afternoon, the set and costumes were minimal, but when feeding back the children told us that they had enjoyed seeing the skeletons and one child even drew us a picture of the Hydra.
