An International Graduate Conference in Greek Comedy, in honour of Angus M. Bowie, took place on 20 and 21 May 2017 at the Ioannou Centre, Oxford. It was organized under the auspices of the Faculty of Classics and The Queen's College and funded by the Craven Committee, the APGRD, and the Classical Association.

The keynote speakers were Professors Oliver Taplin (Oxford) and Michael Silk (KCL) and the rest of the speakers, 24 in number, included academics and graduate students – coming from 16 different universities, from 5 different countries (UK, USA, Greece, Italy, Germany).
