When I left Smyrna on Thursday June 3, the Ottoman Bank had not received advice of any money for me. I hoped to have it ready at hand there on June 1, but perhaps I made some mistake. We are now pretty close pressed for money, I have not a penny left to draw on till the remittance arrives.

We did not start from the Railway Terminus till June 5, as Brown caught a bad attack of diarrhoea the day he reached Smyrna & could not leave Smyrna when I did.
