The following ~~members~~^{candidates} who had been proposed at the previous meeting were duly elected members of the Society. viz: Sir Henry Maine, Messrs E. Fynes Clinton, R. R. Whitehead, The Rev^d J Russell Washbourn^{and} E. L. Hicks.

Eight new candidates were proposed.

A cheque was then drawn to the amount of £12.10 in payment of the half year's rent to the Royal Asiatic Society for the use of their rooms.

The question was raised of the Society's Library. Nothing was settled as to a Librarian but a bookcase was ordered to be made for the books already accumulated, and the Hon. Sec. was instructed to have a stamp made with the name of the Society.

An application was read from the Library of University College London asking to be allowed to subscribe to the Journal of Hellenic Studies at the reduced rate. This was granted.

An application was also read from Canon Greenwell

asking whether in view of the Dean & Chapter of Durham wishing to take the Journal for the Cathedral Library, it would be possible for them as a corporate body to enjoy ~~the privileges~~ to become a member of the Society. This was considered & the Hon. Sec. was instructed to say that under the present Rules this was certainly not feasible, but that the Council would be glad to consider any proposal Canon Greenwell might make on the subject. The Committee then adjourned!
