The Hon. Sec. then read letters from the  
Ἰατρικὸς Society at Athens acknowledging the  
proposal of the Council to establish mutual relations &  
sending a set of the Ἰατρικὸς Journal (2) from Mr  
J. P. Misto, merchant of Smyrna, sending a donation of  
£38. ~~10~~ and some of the publications of the Evangelical  
School at Smyrna, (3) and from Professor Miller <sup>of the Institut</sup> of  
H. Paris, sending a donation of his various works to  
the Society's Library. These letters the Secretary  
was instructed to answer with due acknowledgments.

The Library question then being raised Mr  
Myers expressed his willingness to take the office of  
Librarian provisionally, until some definite arrangement,  
whether of a Committee or of a permanent paid Librarian,  
had been should be arrived at.
