The question is really one of size. A small reduction does not really anticipate final publication. It lays one down. Type after last season's work has practically got to plan of later Palace with its fixed shape & omitting some details belonging to the earlier building - which must appear separately. What Hogarth asks for was a reproduction of this on a small scale - like that of the Annual. To this there could be

no objection.

Now it appears that owing to
a mistake on the part of their repre-
senter the place has been excavated on
a large scale. This is a real anti-
cipation of final publication & I
have written to Hooper that his mis-
take must be corrected.
